Detailed course content (weekly class schedule)	Professional practice will be held in the research centers of FCT "Don Frane Bulić" and "Hieronymianum", in the FCT library as well as in some institutions outside the FCT. The order of the practice will be tailored to individual students or groups students. The practice is distributed as follows: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- (2 hours) introduction to the activities of the research center "Hieronymianum",</li> <li>- (2 hours) introduction to the activities of the research center "Don Frane Bulić",</li> <li>- (4 hours) getting acquainted with the book fund and all other resources of the KBF center and library and the seminary library "Ivan Paštrić" with special emphasis on the patristic fund and series of critical editions</li> <li>- (4 hours) introduction to the archives, Archbishop's Archives Split, recorded material from various archives)</li> <li>- (18 hours) research work related to the translation of patristic texts</li> <li>- (18 hours) research work related to the study, processing and publication of historical sources</li> <li>- (12 hours) research work related to the organization of scientific conferences and preparation of Proceedings</li> </ul>
